

In another race that was held over from December last year due to bad weather the Litton Christmas Cracker took place on Sunday. 139 runners took part in the 7.6 mile fell race with 1,181 feet of climb, most of which was to be found on the long drag up to the trig point at Wardlow. Bryan Lomas was in attendance for the Congleton Harriers and after a sluggish start, he got into his racing stride and claimed a good few places back as his speed picked up and by the time he crossed the finish line he'd bagged himself a top twenty place, finishing 19th in 60:59. A pleasing result and improving on his time out at the 2016 race.

With great organisation from Buxton AC, recently awarded England Athletics National club of the year and a route that featured muddy paths, open fields and wet limestone it's a race sure to attract more Congleton Harriers in the future, whatever time of year it's on.
