

# Congleton Half Marathon

## Marshall Point Number: 5

Distance from Finish: 1.5 miles

**Location:** Hallgreen Lane/ Swettenham Road junction

Number of marshals assigned: 2

### General Instructions:

1. The safety of runners, marshals and other road users is the first priority of all marshals.
2. Make sure you always face oncoming traffic in your marshal position.
3. Please park cars safely and ensure you don't obstruct the road for runners or drivers..
4. Provide directions to runners as specified below. Please use hand signals and spoken instructions; tired runners don't always listen!
5. If a runner retires, please contact Marshal Control and we'll try to collect them as soon as possible.
6. Please offer words of encouragement, a smile, information on distance remaining etc.

### Position Specific Instructions – OUTWARD DIRECTION

Swettenham Road will be closed and no traffic allowed onto Hall Green Lane (except emergency vehicles) from 9.25. The marshals are responsible for erecting the barrier on Swettenham Road provided by Amberon. This is to prevent any traffic on Radnor Bank at the start of the race.

1. At 9.25 approx Erect the barrier provided by Amberon across Swettenham Road to close it before the race starts to stop traffic.
2. Ask drivers trying to leave Swettenham Road to wait until all runners have passed.
3. Traffic will not be allowed into Hall Green Lane from Giantswood Lane by Amberon
4. Remind runners to keep on left.
5. When the sweepers have passed, remove barrier and let traffic move along Swettenham Road again.

### Position Specific Instructions – INWARD DIRECTION

1. Marshals to warn drivers of runners
2. Direct runners to continue on Hallgreen Lane towards Radnor Bank
3. Direct to run on left

### Equipment:

Bib – please wear these for your safety

Mobile Phone with number of marshal control (07795 697842)

**At End:**

Wait until Sweeper passes and confirms all runners now passed by.

Return bib to Marshal Control at Congleton High School.
